

## Getting Books for Your Students

### Physical Books

<b>SWS Library Books</b>  *Search the SWS Library Catalog  <a href="https://dcps.follettdestiny.com/">https://dcps.follettdestiny.com/</a>	Students can request SWS library books by emailing Ms. Fravel throughout the week and picking up materials on Wednesdays, 1pm-5pm. (details sent to families)
<b>DC Public Library</b>  <a href="https://www.dclibrary.org/">https://www.dclibrary.org/</a>  <a href="https://www.dclibrary.org/getacard">https://www.dclibrary.org/getacard</a>	Students or families must have a DC Public Library Card (free) and may have to wait/schedule book pick up.  <i>If you need a library card:</i> apply online and pick up at any open branch. Students who have a DC One Card can use that number to access public library materials.

### Electronic Books *(students will read on a tablet or computer)*

<b>Epic School</b>  <a href="https://www.getepic.com/students">https://www.getepic.com/students</a>  *Used mainly for in-school independent or choice reading	Available via the Clever platform, with free access from 7am-4pm. All students have access with their homeroom class code. After school hours are limited to 2 hours per week (with Epic Free).
<b>Learning A to Z</b>  *Used mainly for access to leveled reading text and in-school small reading groups.	Available via the Clever platform with unlimited access to Raz-Plus and Raz-Kids.
<b>Sora Overdrive</b>	Available via the Clever platform and can be linked to a DC Public Library account to borrow books/audio books electronically, without a wait.
<b>DC Public Library</b>  <a href="https://www.dclibrary.org/">https://www.dclibrary.org/</a>	Students or families must have a DC Public Library Card (free) and can check out books to be delivered electronically.
